REVISED LIST OF COUNTRIES WHOSE NATIONALS ARE EXEMPTED FROM ENTRY VISAS TO GHANA

- A. **ECOWAS Citizens** – Benin, Burkina Faso, Cote D'Ivoire, Cape Verde, Gambia, Guinea, Guinea Bissau, Liberia, Mali, Niger, Nigeria, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Togo
- B. Egypt, Kenya, Singapore, Trinidad and Tobago
- C. Holders of Diplomatic/Service Passports of Brazil, Cuba, Germany, Iran and Hong Kong, Special Administrative Region (SAR) of China, and South Africa (for a period not exceeding three (3) months).
- D. Persons in direct Airside transit.
- E. Holders of official passports of the African Union, Regional Economic Communities in Africa, United Nations and its specialized agencies:
 - * The World Bank
 - * African Development Bank
 - * International Monetary Fund
 - * World Food Programme
- F. Nationals of the following Commonwealth, East and Southern African countries require **Gratis Visas** to enter into Ghana: Botswana, Lesotho, Malawi, Swaziland, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia and Zimbabwe.
